**Revisions starting in October 2012 (Q4):**  
 Event numbers were renamed and reordered  
 For all the events where the phrase "patient death or serious disability" occurred, the phrase "patient death or serious injury" was used.  
 The three events Hypoglycemia, Hyperbilirubinemia, and Spinal manipulative therapy under Care Management were reclassified to Patient Protection Events.  
 The three events; Neonate death or serious injury, Irretrievable loss of an irreplaceable biological specimen, and Pressure ulcers were reclassified to Care Management Events.  
 † Procedure Events includes surgical or invasive procedures  
 † Infant was broadened to include a patient/ resident of any age  
 † Patient suicide, attempted suicide was broadened to include self-harm  
 † Pressure ulcers were broadened to include unstageable pressure ulcers  
 † Sexual assault was broadened to include sexual abuse/ assault on a patient or staff member
