WN-I019-2, Amendment 43

This is to inform you that the Washington State Department of Health, Office of Radiation Protection (department) has administratively amended US Ecology Washington, Inc's (USEW's), State of Washington Radioactive Materials License WN-I019-2. The Radioactive Materials License was amended to include a license condition for leak testing sealed and electroplated sources, a requirement to submit waste manifests in CD/DVD format, a schedule for revising the Site Stabilization and Closure Plan, and editorial and typographical corrections.

The department concludes that the amendment of USEW's Radioactive Materials License WN-I019-2 complies with applicable radiation protection laws and regulations contained in RCW 70A.388 and Chapter 246-250 WAC. There are no changes to Radioactive Materials License WN-I019-2 that have not already been evaluated under existing SEPA documents. Amendment 43 and an addendum to existing SEPA documents are attached and will be posted on the department's website at: https://doh.wa.gov/community-and-environment/radiation/waste-management/commercial-low-level-radioactive-waste-disposal.
