# Single Sign-On (SSO)

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- "Single Sign-On (SSO)" refers to a link between your Secure Access Washington (SAW) account and your IIS user account.
- Technical issues have caused several implementation delays, but we anticipate completion sometime this summer.
- After your initial SSO link is established between SAW and the IIS, you will not be required to enter login credentials in the IIS...only "Login SAW".

# Single Sign-On (SSO)

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- A separate SAW account will be needed for each IIS user account. Most users should not need more than one IIS user account. If you do, you will need a SAW account for each one.
  - The same email address can be used for each account.
- IIS System Administrators should use IIS user reports to monitor their clinic's IIS user accounts.
  - Inactivate users when they no longer need access.
  - Ensure that a valid email address exists for each user account.
  - Make sure usernames are NOT email addresses and do not contain special characters.

# Deduplication Changes

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- Previously, when more than one vaccination of the same vaccine family/group was submitted for a patient within five days of each other, the IIS automatically deduplicated the record
- The most recently 'administered' vaccine would replace the others given within that 5-day period
- This 5-day threshold has been changed in the registry to 1 day
  - This change was implemented to accommodate recording vaccines such as Rabies where doses are administered to a patient more frequently than 5 days apart

# Digital Information Sharing Agreements

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- The Exchange/View Information Sharing Agreements necessary to access the WA IIS must now be submitted through a digital webform
- Processing time for submissions with complete and accurate information may be as short as 1 week
  - \*Incomplete submissions will be deleted, and a new agreement will need to be submitted for review**
- All new digital agreements expire 3 years after approval

# Interoperability Statistics

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- In 2023
  - 89% of data received via HL7
  - 10% Direct Entry
  - 1% DTT
- 2,607 facilities submitted HL7 (377 organizations)
- IIS received over 10 million HL7 messages reporting vaccines
  - Over 41 million HL7 messages querying the IIS for immunization records
