On March 8, 2024, the Examining Board of Psychology held a hybrid meeting via Microsoft Teams and in-person at Washington State Department of Health, Town Center East 2 (TC2) Building, Room #153, 111 Israel Road SE, Tumwater, WA 98501. 1. Opening of Public Meeting – Cedar O'Donnell, Ph.D., Chair

- 1.1. Call to Order: The chair called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. followed by introductions of board members, department staff, the Assistant Attorney General, and guests.
- 1.2. Approval of the Agenda: *Motion to approve the agenda, seconded, vote 7-0.*

2. SSHB 1724: Increasing the Trained Behavioral Health Workforce Update – 1724 Implementation - Nancy Delgado, Program Manager

- 2.1. Ms. Delgado presented the CR-101 for the permanent rules package for the board to review. *Motion to approve the CR-101, with recommendations around changes to the national examination language, seconded, vote 6-0 with one abstention.*

Ms. Delgado presented the emergency rules draft language for the board to review and discuss. *Motion to approve rules language around reexaminations as discussed, seconded, vote 7-0. Motion to revert to the original definition of reciprocity and add a new definition for endorsement, seconded, vote 7-0. Motion to not include the jurisprudence exam for any endorsement pathway, was not seconded. Motion to require jurisprudence exam for pathways 2 and 3 for the purposes of emergency rule making, seconded, vote 6-1. Discussion around the table of Content Areas is tabled for further committee work and discussion. Discussion around the three options for courses outside of a doctoral program is tabled for further committee work and discussion.* Two topics were brought up to discuss once permanent rule making begins: lobbying for changes to require all pathways for endorsement to take the jurisprudence exam and addressing jurisprudence through continuing education.

3. PSYPACT Commissioner Election – Cedar O'Donnell, Ph.D., Chair

The board nominated and elected the new PSYPACT Commissioner to represent the board.

- 3.1. Dr. Hawley self-nominated to serve as the new PSYPACT Commissioner representing the board. *Motion to elect Dr. Hawley as the PSYPACT Commissioner representing the board, seconded, vote 6-0, 1 abstention.*

4. Board Recruitment – Nancy Delgado, Program Manager

The board reviewed recruitment options for the open board membership positions. *Motion to move forward with the original recruitment package and start over for the new vacant position, seconded, vote 7-0.* Dr. Carlile, Ms. Katz Burstein, Dr. Freedman, Dr. Hawley, and Dr. O'Donnell volunteered to participate in the next round of interviews for new board members.
