Hepatitis C is a serious but curable disease that can lead to liver damage, cancer, and even death. Safe and effective treatment is available. The first step to health is knowing your hepatitis C status.

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Dear healthcare provider,



I want to be screened for hepatitis C. The CDC recommends that anyone over age 18 get tested for hepatitis C at least once in their lifetime. If I test reactive and am confirmed to have a current infection, I would like to begin treatment as soon as possible.

I would also like to be vaccinated against hepatitis A & B, if my records indicate I am at risk for these infections.
