  - After explanation, participants liked the term “credentialed” as it is broader than “licensed” so that change was appreciated.
  - Transportation – can an exception be written to exclude ride share or taxi use. A suggestion to add “or other means as clinically/medically appropriate” to keep it broader. For example, what if uber gets a medical ride share option one day?
    - Participants agree with an edit of “other means when medically appropriate”.
  - Definition of a provider (physician, PA, ARNP) – Need to change ARNP to APRN. Otherwise all participants were happy with it.
  - Participant asked again about direct admit from H@H which would be a change from the CMS waiver. If a patient was identified via urgent care and heading towards inpatient, but before they enter the ER, they could be admitted to H@H instead.
    - Conversation about some insurance companies trialing this but that it’s happening under a providers license, not a hospitals license.

- Conversation about the requirements of the legislation and some participants will follow-up offline with additional information for the department.
