• Renewals: 1,672 (-6%)

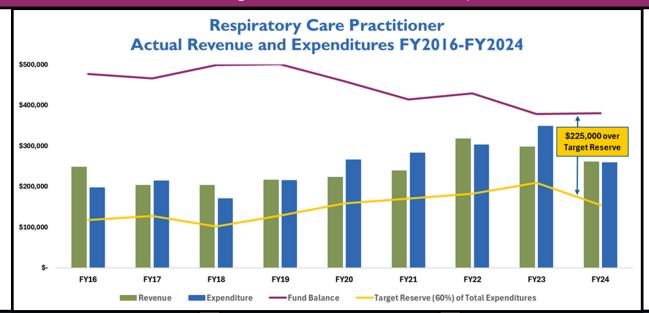
Expenditures: \$258,000

Significant Highlights

- Overall, costs decreased 26%, primarily due to an office redistribution of program staff, a decline in HELMS obligations, and one-time funding to support credentialing backlogs.
- Disciplinary costs increased due to heightened legal activity.

- Annual application growth:<1%
- Annual average renewal rate: 87%

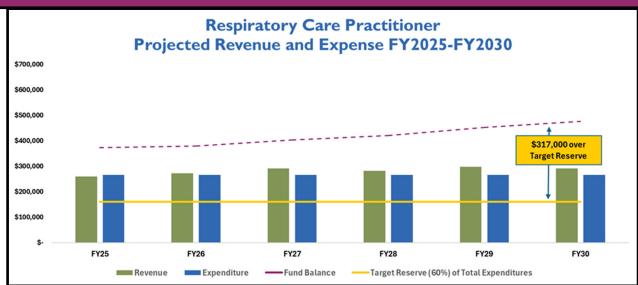
Cost Projections

- Average annual cost: \$266,000
- Expense growth rate FY2025: -4%
- Subsequent growth: 1% annually, driven by inflation, personnel-related expenses, and disciplinary costs

Fee Activity Projections

- The department reduced fees in FY2016 to lower the surplus to the target reserve of 60%.
- The fund's surplus is projected to continue increasing over target fund levels, leading to a possible fee decrease in 1-2 years.
