We have completed review of your letter and supporting documentation regarding the pediatric level of care for University of Washington Medical Center based on the February 2013 level of care guidelines. Below is the information considered and the facts relied upon by the Certificate of Need Program in reaching the conclusion.

INFORMATION CONSIDERED

- Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70.38
- Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 246-310
- Washington State Perinatal and Neonatal Level of Care Guidelines, February 2013
- University of Washington Medical Center's May 15, 2015, Determination of Reviewability (DOR) request
- Certificate of Need historical files for University of Washington Medical Center

CONCLUSION

Based on the totality of information considered, University of Washington Medical Center is recognized as a level IV provider as described in the February 2013 level of care guidelines. The department further recognizes that University of Washington Medical Center has 35 level III neonatal intensive care beds at the hospital and all 35 beds would be available for level IV use. Please note that any increase in level IV pediatric beds beyond 35 requires prior Certificate of Need review and approval.
