Dear Mr. Moore:

Enclosed is Replacement Authorization (RA) #097 issued to Total Renal Care a subsidiary of DaVita Inc. approving the replacement of DaVita Puyallup Dialysis Center to a new site within Pierce County ESRD Planning Area 1. At completion, DaVita Puyallup Dialysis Center will have 20 approved stations as noted on the certificate and described in the application.

Replacement Authorization #097 is valid for two years. The project must begin during this time. If there is substantial and continuing progress, we may extend the authorization for one six month period. For an extension, you must submit an extension request at least 120 days before the expiration date. You cannot begin a project after the expiration date.

This decision may be appealed. The two appeal options are listed below.

Appeal Option 1:

You or any interested or affected person may request a public hearing to reconsider this decision. The request must state the specific reasons for reconsideration in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-310-560. A reconsideration request must be received within 28 calendar days from the date of the decision at one of the following addresses:

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Appeal Option 2:

You or any affected person with standing may request an adjudicative proceeding to contest this decision within 28 calendar days from the date of this letter. Description of Approved Project

This relocation exemption approves Total Renal Care Inc. to relocate the 20-station DaVita Puyallup Dialysis Center in its entirety. At completion Total Renal Care’s facility is approved to certify and operate 20-stations. Services provided at the facility include hemodialysis, backup dialysis service, isolation station, home hemodialysis training, permanent bed station, and shifts beginning after 5pm. A breakdown of the approved 20 stations is shown below:
