Dear Mr. Pollock:

Enclosed is Certificate of Need #1491A issued to Northwest Kidney Centers approving the amendment of Certificate of Need #1491 issued to Northwest Kidney Centers on October 24, 2012. This amended Certificate of Need approves a change in the site and capital expenditure.

The certificate is not approval for any other local, federal, or state statutes, rules, or regulations. Such a project may also need Department of Health approval for a construction plan and facility licensing or certification, as well as other federal or local jurisdiction permits.

This Certificate of Need does not change the validity period for Certificate of Need #1491. The project must begin during the time stated on the enclosed certificate. If there is substantial and continuing progress, we may extend the certificate for one six month period. For an extension, you must submit an extension request at least 120 days before the expiration. You cannot begin a project after the expiration date.

This decision may be appealed. The two appeal options are listed below.

Appeal Option 1:

An affected person may request a public hearing to reconsider this decision. The request must state the specific reasons for reconsideration in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-310-560. A reconsideration request must be received within 28 calendar days from the date of the decision at one of the following addresses:

Appeal Option 2:

An affected person with standing may request an adjudicative proceeding to contest this decision within 28 calendar days from the date of this letter. The notice of appeal must be filed according to the provisions of Revised Code of Washington 34.05 and Washington Administrative Code 246-310-610.
