Activities in the Growing Area in 2023

The growing area is classified for the subtidal harvest of scallops only. Product harvested from the growing area was relayed to a grow-out site in Shoal Bay. Relay activities are approved from November 1 through April 30 each year. A routine three-year shoreline evaluation was completed and no new or changes in pollution sources were identified.

Analytical Results of Water Samples

A marine station (102) is located in the growing area solely for the purposes of approving relay harvest activities. The station is not shown on the growing area map. No water samples are collected from this station.

Change in Actual Pollution Sources that Impact the Growing Area

We currently have no information indicating that the area has new sources of pollution.


