

Wastewater Disposal Plan

Floatation System Facility Construction Permit Application



Float water contains large amounts of Epsom salts (magnesium sulfate), and it may cause problems if it is not disposed of properly.

- If you are discharging float water into the sanitary sewer, obtain a letter from the sewer company stating that they are willing to accept waste float water.
- If you are having waste float water collected by a pumper truck, obtain a letter from the company agreeing to collect your waste float water.
- If you are discharging waste float water in to a septic system, obtain a letter from the local health jurisdiction (www.doh.wa.gov/localhealth) who is regulating the system stating that discharging float water into a septic system is within their requirements.
