



Risk Factors for Late Onset Hearing Loss: Craniofacial Anomalies

Craniofacial anomalies include:

- ◆ **Head trauma**
- ◆ **Cleft palate**
- ◆ **Abnormal pinna (outer ear)**
- ◆ **Abnormal ear canal**
- ◆ **Ear tags and pits**
- ◆ **Malformed eyes**
- ◆ **Choanal atresia**
- ◆ **Craniosynostosis**
- ◆ **Hemifacial microsomia**
