Assess growth or prenatal weight gain based on weights and measurements and share with participant.	 Measure children under 24 months on a recumbent length board. Measure children 24 months and older and adults using stadiometer. Weigh infants and children under 24 months on pediatric scale. Weigh children 24 months and older and adults using an adult scale. Record measurements and weights in participant's file. Assess growth charts and prenatal weight gain grids in computer system. Assess breastfeeding and non-breastfeeding postpartum participant's BMI. Offer to share child's growth chart with participant. Offer to share prenatal weight gain grid with pregnant participant.
